To celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Ways In Being Gay Biennial, started by then Hallwalls' performance curator Ron Ehmke, Hallwalls Media Arts program will extend this ground breaking series from a month long affair to a year-long project. To kick start the program, we commence with a tribute to British filmmaker Derek Jarman (1942-1994). Hallwalls and the MAFAC partner to bring Jarman's seminal film BLUE (1993, 35mm) released just four months before his death by AIDS-related complications. Jarman's life and work is the subject of a new documentary DEREK, a collaboration between British artist Issac Julien and Tilda Swinton, Jarman's friend and muse. Stay tuned throughout the year for screenings, performances, workshops, and more!
