## VICTORIA BRADBURY

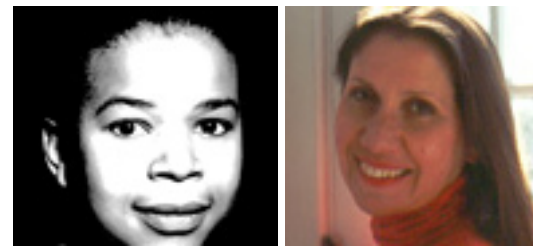

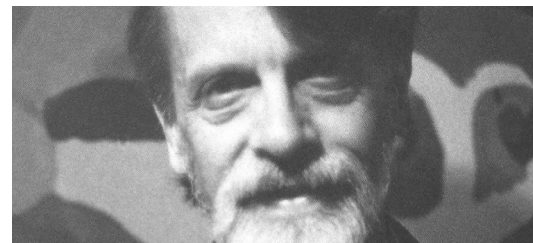
